Cascade Clamps - Established in Portland, Oregon in the year 1943, the Cascade Manufacturing Company started as a small machine store hiring only 4 individuals. Total sales for that initial year amounted to about 60 thousand dollars. The very first recorded sales revenues involved the assembly and machining of stainless steel valves, pipe fittings and other components. During five years of operation, the company had expanded to 40 staff and their yearly sales volume had risen to \$330,000. At present, Cascade is amongst the top global makers in the material handling trade.

Design and manufacturing of the company's first hydraulic cylinder allowed this young company to aggressively pursue better business opportunities. Throughout the final sixty years, the business of material handling has developed into a really sophisticated field with Cascade proudly playing a part in its development. Cascade at present continues to develop as the best provider of lift truck accessories and different associated products. The business feels confident in their ability in order to continue to lead the way within the business by understanding buyer's requirements in the future and remaining competitive within the world market.

Through the nineteen fifties, Cascade started to manufacture, design, and promote its hydraulic attachments. A brand new facility was built in the year 1956, to house all of the plant operations and offices in Portland, Oregon, which remains to be the company's present headquarters. After 15 years of business, total employees reached 180 employees and sales had reached almost 2.3 million dollars.

A second production plant was built in 1959 in Springfield, Ohio. The year 1960 marked Cascade's initial move into the global world of the material handling industry while the business established interest in the Netherlands, England, and Australia.

In 1964, the company altered its name to the Cascade Corporation. Then in the year 1965, the company went public with a preliminary offering of 200,000 shares of common stock. Ever since then the company has expanded its manufacturing services throughout the continental US to the areas Warner Robins Georgia to go along with its already present plants in Springfield, Ohio and Portland, Oregon. Cascade merchandise are made internationally due to a lot of subsidiary operations. In the year 1944, a new plant was completed in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European head office. This plant is made to be the ultimate customer service centre.

Cascade further expanded their product base in the year 1996 and 1997 subsequent to buying 5 corporations, which included the Kenhar Corporation, the global leader in blades.
